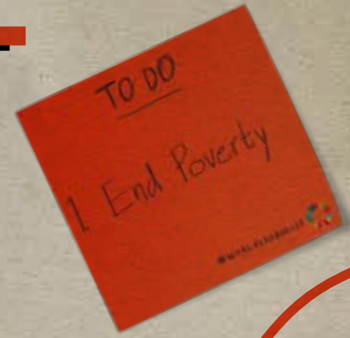


YOUTH TOPIA YOU UNITE

TO DO LIST SDG 1



This to-do list for SDG 1: No Poverty was created by youth from around the world in consultation with YOUTHTOPIA's Circle of Youth members throughout multiple meetings, research sessions and debates. This is a call to action from young people on the frontlines to government, corporates and individuals like you!

Government:

- 1) Distribute loans and grants to people and businesses in disadvantaged communities.
- 2) Reflect on historic discrimination of minority groups and create plans that amend generational disadvantages.
- 3) Set and enforce fair and dynamic minimum wage rates in consultation with experts.
- 4) Ensure accessible and affordable health care and education from an early age.
- 5) Develop and implement training programs to increase employability.

Example: You Lead, an organisation founded by Circle of Youth member Shalmali Jadhav that connects mentors with amateur entrepreneurs.

Corporations:

- 1) Ensure fair wages and benefits such as health insurance and paid sick leave.
- 2) Provide opportunities of employment to local community members.
- 3) Develop products and services tailored for customers living in poverty.
- 4) Partner with organisations to provide education and entrepreneurial skills training.
- 5) Improve access to basic goods and services for people living in poverty.

Example: For the Future Philippines, an organisation founded by Circle of Youth member Issa Barte that provides basic services such as electricity to families in the Philippines.

Individuals:

- 1) Support non-profit organisations through donations and volunteering.

Example: Ensemble pour Techo, an organisation founded by Circle of Youth member nés Yábar that organises fundraisers to support community development projects by Latin American youth.

- 2) Inform yourself and spread the word.
- 3) Purchase goods and services from smallholders.
- 4) Ask local corporations and government to update and implement minimum wage policies.
- 5) Provide communities living in poverty with commodities they cannot afford.

Example: Raise Uganda Now, an organisation founded by Circle of Youth Member Keunseon Park that provides families in Uganda with housing and education.
