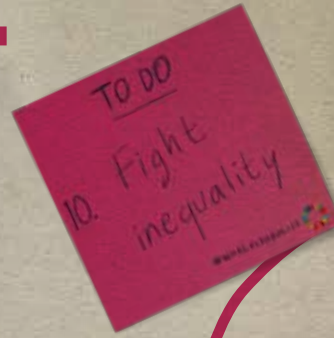


YOUTH TOPIA YOUNITE

SDG 10



This to-do list for SDG 10: Reduced Inequality was created by youth from around the world in consultation with YOUTHTOPIA's Circle of Youth members throughout multiple meetings, research sessions and debates. This is a call to action from young people on the frontlines to government, corporates and individuals like you!

Government:

- 1) Implement SDG 10 in the national educational curriculum.
- 2) Ensure access to quality education for people with disabilities.
- 3) Develop policies that protect individuals from discriminatory practices; create forums where community members are able to collaborate on the creations of policy.
- 4) Protect communities that may be most severely impacted by environmental hazards.
Example: Learn Blue, a platform founded by Circle of Youth member Joshua Oluwaseyi to spread awareness about pollution and its effects on health.
- 5) Enforce strict measures that hold corporations accountable.

Corporations:

- 1) Develop a strong equality policy to ensure that no worker is at disadvantage.
- 2) Develop products and services tailored for a broad audience.
- 3) Recruit, train and employ local community members and integrate them in your value to contribute to meaningful change.
- 4) Improve access to basic goods and services for people living in poverty.
- 5) Partner with civil society networks to provide education and entrepreneurial skills training.

Individuals:

- 1) Support other activists and organisations.
- 2) Include underprivileged groups and minorities in the conversation.
- 3) Report discriminatory behaviours.
- 4) Facilitate programmes to engage members of your community.
Example: Circle of Youth member Marlow Baines, an activist hosting learning opportunities for youth to get involved in the movement.
- 5) Advocate for equality.
Example: Circle of Youth member Vinkha Adinda, an activist and public speaker who addresses the intersectionality between equality and other SDGs.
Example: Circle of Youth member Jesslyn Tania, an activist who focuses on issues related to the rights of women and youth.
