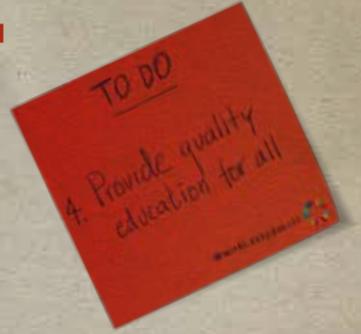


YOUTH TOPIA YOUNITE

This to-do list for SDG 4: Quality Education was created by youth from around the world in consultation with YOUTHTOPIA's Circle of Youth members throughout multiple meetings, research sessions and debates. This is a call to action from young people on the frontlines to government, corporates and individuals like you!

Government:

- 1) Implement efficient literacy programmes in schools.
- 2) Update educational curriculums according to the students' needs.
- 3) Ensure education is inclusive and equitable.
- 4) Build and upgrade education facilities that are child, disability and gender sensitive.
- 5) Make teachers' salaries more competitive.

Corporations:

- 1) Offer apprenticeship opportunities for youth to have early access to the corporate environment.
Example: Gores Denai, an organisation founded by Circle of Youth member Ayesha Felice to educate and offer opportunities to youth interested in international affairs.
Example: Danone x Youthtopia partnership, which provides Indonesian youth the opportunity to develop their own sustainable product into the market.
- 2) Provide employees with continuous capacity-building opportunities to improve their skills for their current and future employment.
- 3) Allow flexible schedules for employees who are enrolled in higher education.
- 4) Keep research publications accessible to the general public.
- 5) Invest in scholarship funds to provide opportunities to disadvantaged young people

Individuals:

- 1) Engage in your children's education by observing their progress and supporting education at home.
- 2) Validate information you perceive through credible sources either online or in a public library.
- 3) Support and volunteer for organisations that provide education to underprivileged children.
Example: Gharsah Sweden, an organisation founded by Circle of Youth member Mohamad Al Jounde to provide education to refugees living in camps.
- 4) Spark conversations that provide opportunities to learn
Example: Arise Arose, a information platform developed by Circle of Youth Member Olivina "Peachy Liv" Maskan.
